Rogerio Tutti is a pianist with a powerful gift for communication whose sensitive and insightful interpretations have brought him to the forefront of his generation. Born in Brazil, Rogerio currently performs internationally in the main halls of the piano world. At BEA Rogério will present works by Chopin, Stravinsky and Villa-Lobos. Mr. Rogerio Tutti has an international career as a pianist and has appeared in several concert halls in Portugal, Russia, Chile, Cuba Brazil and USA. His prolific career has allowed him to be the recipient of numerous prizes including: 3rd prize in the "Claudio Arrau" International Piano Competition, Chile, the Best interpreter of Latino-American music in the "Amadeo Roldan" International Piano Competitor Cuba, 1st prize in MTNA Piano Competition in North Dakota, and 1st prize in "Artlivre" Nation Piano Competition in Brazil.

#### **Music: Júlia Tygel, piano, Nelly Rocha, cello**

Júlia Tygel - Entremeados ('Intertwined'): Brazilian music for cello and piano. Intertwining classical and Brazilian popular universes, pianist Júlia Tygel presents the repertory of her first CD, featuring composers Tom Jobim and Chico Buarque, as well as her own compositions. She performs with cellist Nelly Rocha. Júlia Tygel is a young Brazilian pianist and composer. Having started piano at 7, she graduated and concluded her Master's degree of Music in Brazil. Having received many grants and awards, she is now based in New York as a PhD visiting research scholar in Music Theory. In 2011 she recorded her first CD, "Júlia Tygel – Entremeados", produced by pianist Benjamim Taubkin and supported by her home town's cultural department. Her compositions and arrangements mix influences of a classical musical education with Brazilian rich popular music. She has been playing this repertory at important venues dedicated to instrumental music in Sao Paulo and abroad, being recognized as one of the most talented Brazilian musicians of her generation.
